

Looking for free birth control?

People of all ages and all genders can get coverage for birth control, STI testing and treatment, and other services with no out-of-pocket cost with the HUSKY Family Planning Program!



You can apply if:

- You're a resident of Connecticut.
- Your household income, before taxes, is less than: or equal to:
 - \$3,498/month for a family of 1
 - \$4,743/month for a family of 2
 - \$5,987/month for a family of 3
 - \$7,232/month for a family of 4
 - \$8,477/month for a family of 5
 - \$9,722/month for a family of 6
- You are not already enrolled in a public health coverage program (i.e. Medicaid/HUSKY).
- You're a U.S. citizen or have a qualifying immigration status.



Here's what you can get for free:

- Annual check-up, if related to family planning.
- All FDA-approved birth control methods, including emergency contraception, IUD, implant, pills, condoms, patch, ring, Depo-Provera, tubal ligation and vasectomy.
- Pap smears/pap follow-up.
- STI testing/treatment.
- HPV, Hep B vaccines.



You should also know that...

- You can apply for healthcare coverage at accesshealthct.com. If you're not eligible for a program that covers all of your healthcare needs, but are eligible for HUSKY Family Planning, you will be enrolled within 45 days.
- You can also apply at connect.ct.gov if you have private insurance you can't use because it doesn't cover birth control, or if you have privacy concerns.



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
